Plant a pot inside



The Pot Place shows you how to prepare an indoor pot with a controlled watering system, which is easy to use and fits most indoor pots perfectly.

You will need the following:

- Ceramic pot
- Indoor plant
- Potting soil
- Controlled watering system Plastic pot with a hole at the bottom Plug to seal the hole Soil deck with grooves at the bottom Fill pipe
 - Gauge
- Decorative ceramic pebbles, bark chips, gemstones, pieces of glass or sea shells
 Metal stand

A controlled watering system is particularly useful for the maintenance of pot plants and help ensure plants are healthier.

Overwatering pot plants is one of the main reasons for plants dying.

How to use your controlled watering system

- Securely insert the plug in the bottom of the plastic pot.
- Insert the soil deck at the bottom.
- Insert the fill pipe.
- Plant the indoor plant in the plastic pot.

• The soil deck creates a space at the bottom of the pot that acts as a water reservoir when water is poured down the fill pipe. The gauge indicates how much water you have in the system. When watering, the indicator should rise to the first mark – about 1 to 2 liters of water.

• You can only refill with water once the gauge is completely dry.

These controlled watering systems come in a number of sizes and are available from The Pot Place (R65 – R300).
